

Military Grant Agreement  
Between Georgia and The Hellenic  
Republic

Georgia and the Hellenic Republic (hereinafter referred to as "the parties") taking into consideration close relations existing between the parties and wishing to further develop their bilateral cooperation.

Considering the agreement on "Military Technical Cooperation between Georgia and the Hellenic Republic" signed on January 9, 1998,

Have agreed, as follows:

Article I

The Hellenic Republic will grant military equipment to Georgia (free of charge), with the purpose of restructuring the Armed Forces of Georgia.

Article II

The Hellenic Republic will deliver to Georgia the following equipment, the total cost of which is 184240 (one hundred eighty four thousand and two hundred forty) Euro:

- a) Canteen (500 item)
- b) Bag for Canteen (500 item)
- c) Field Uniform (3000 item)
- d) Jacket (3000 item)
- e) Shovel (50 items)
- f) Hoe (60 item)
- g) Radio Transmitters RACAL PRM-4720 (10 item)
- h) Mortars (60 item).

Article III

The General Staff of Army of the Hellenic Republic and the Ministry of Defense of Georgia shall be responsible for the implementation of the present Agreement.

Article IV

Georgia will bear the costs of transportation of the above-mentioned equipment

from the Hellenic Republic to Georgia and will also be responsible for both customs clearance and delivery of that equipment to the place of its final destination.

#### Article V

Georgia agrees not to transfer equipment to another country or the third party, without the preliminary consent from the Hellenic Republic.

#### Article VI

Any disputes arising from the implementation of the present Agreement will be settled through mutual negotiations.

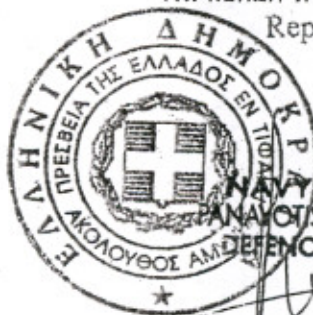
The present Agreement shall enter into force on the date of receipt of the last written notification by which either of the parties informs the other (through diplomatic channels) that the internal legal procedures required for its entry into force have been accomplished.

Done in Tbilisi, on 24.05.2007 in two originals in the Greek, Georgian, and English languages, all texts being equally authentic. In case of divergence of interpretation, the English text shall prevail.
