

**BETWEEN  
GEORGIA AND THE REPUBLIC OF TURKEY**

Georgia and the Republic of Turkey; reaffirming their long-existing friendship relations,  
Referring to the Framework Agreement "Between Government of Georgia and Government of the Republic of Turkey in the Fields of Military Training, Technique and Science" of 04.04.1996 and the Agreement "Between Government of Georgia and Government of the Republic of Turkey for Cooperation on Military Fields of Training and Technique" of 14.07.1997,

And for the purposes of strengthening their military cooperation and contributing to the restructuring of the Armed Forces of Georgia, have agreed on the following:

**ARTICLE I**

The Republic of Turkey shall grant 2.822.000 (two million and eight hundred twenty two thousand) YTL equal to U.S. Dollars to Georgia in 2007.

**ARTICLE II**

As part of this agreement, the 2.550.000 (two million and five hundred fifty thousand) YTL equal to U.S. Dollars grant will be provided as material and services, the 272.000 (two hundred seventy two thousand) YTL equal to U.S. Dollars will be provided as cash, in accordance with the respective legislations of the parties.

**ARTICLE III**

2.822.000 (two million and eight hundred twenty two thousand ) YTL equal to U.S. Dollars grant will be realized in accordance with Financial Assistance and Logistic Implementing Protocols that will be signed between the competent authorities of the two sides reference to this Agreement. The Grant Agreement will be implemented by the Turkish General Staff on behalf of the Republic of Turkey and by the Ministry of Defense and the Ministry of Internal Affairs on behalf of Georgia.

**ARTICLE IV**

Georgia agrees not to transfer title or possession of articles/ services to another country or third party, unless the consent of the Republic of Turkey has first been obtained.

**ARTICLE V**

By mutual consent of the parties, amendments and additions may be introduced into this Agreement which shall be reflected in separate protocols being integral parts of this Agreement and entering into force according to the provision of Article VI of this Agreement.

**ARTICLE VI**

This Agreement shall be effective until all materials and services as specified in the Implementing Protocol of the logistic sphere are completely absorbed by the Ministry of Defense and the Ministry of Internal Affairs of Georgia.


The present Agreement shall enter into force on the date of receipt of the last notification of the parties on the completion of internal procedures necessary of its entry into force.


Any disputes arising during the implementation of this Agreement will be solved via mutual discussions and negotiations.

This Agreement has been signed in Ankara/Turkey on *Oct. 10*, 2007 in two copies, in Georgian, Turkish and English Languages each text shall be equally authentic. In case of disputes regarding the interpretation of this Agreement, the English version will prevail.
