

**THE IMPLEMENTATION PROTOCOL
REGARDING THE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE
BETWEEN
GEORGIA AND THE REPUBLIC OF TURKEY**

Georgia represented by the Ministry of Defense of Georgia and The Republic of Turkey represented by the General Staff of the Republic of Turkey (hereinafter referred to as parties) have agreed on the following articles for the use of the financial assistance that shall be allocated within the scope of Military Grant Agreement.

**ARTICLE I
PURPOSE**

The purpose of this protocol is to establish the implementation essentials of the financial assistance, the 272.000 (two hundred seventy two thousand) YTL. equal to U.S. Dollars, provided by the Republic of Turkey to the Ministry of Defense of Georgia.

**ARTICLE II
SCOPE**

The financial assistance which shall be provided by Turkey will be used to meet the source requirements of the following activities:

1. The personnel allowances of the Georgian Peace Keeping Platoon who participated in KFOR (Kosovo Force) operation,
2. The expenditures of different needs and requirements that will be determined by the parties.

**ARTICLE III
IMPLEMENTATION PRINCIPLES**

The Implementation principles of the financial assistance are stated as follows;

1. 221.000 (two hundred twenty one thousand) YTL. equal to U.S. Dollars is allocated to meet the personnel daily allowances of the Georgian Peace Keeping Platoon which participated in KFOR operation. Following daily payments will be paid at the end of the month:

2. 51.000 (fifty one thousand) YTL. equal to U.S. Dollars is allocated to finance the needs and requirements that are to be agreed between the parties during the validity period of this implementing protocol.

3. The financial source shall be transferred by the Turkish Republic to the bank account that will be determined by the Military Attache in Tbilisi. The implementation of this source will be established by the Turkish Military Attache in Tbilisi.

4. When necessary, the transfer between the sources will be conducted by General Staff of the Republic of Turkey.

**ARTICLE IV
AMENDMENT AND REVISION**

By mutual consent of the parties, amendment and addition may be introduced into this protocol, which shall be reflected in separate protocols being integral parts of this implementing protocol and entering into force according to the provision of Article VII of this implementing protocol.

**ARTICLE V
SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES**

Any disputes arising during the implementation of this implementing protocol shall be solved via discussions and negotiations between the parties.

**ARTICLE VI
PROTOCOL DURATION**

This Protocol shall be valid until using financial assistance source, after the General Staff of Republic of Turkey notifies the Ministry of Defense of Georgia that the transfer of the financial source is concluded.

**ARTICLE VII
APPROVAL AND ENTRY INTO FORCE**

This present Protocol shall enter into force on the date of receipt of the last notification of the parties on the completion of internal procedures necessary of its entry into force.

**ARTICLE VIII
TEXT AND SIGNATURE**


This Protocol was signed in Ankara/Turkey on 10 October 2007 in two copies, in Georgian, Turkish and English languages, each text shall be equally authentic. In case of disputes regarding the interpretation of this protocol, the English version shall prevail.
